## About the Month of Av

Av literally means father. Tradition teaches that The Temple in Jerusalem was destroyed twice -Solomon's Temple by the Babylonians and the Second Temple by the Romans. Destruction of both temples occurred on the 9th of Av. Both times, G-d is there to comfort and console us.

It is customary to add the name "Menachem," which means "comforter" or "consoler"–so Menachem Av.

Av also incorporates a "high point": the 15th of Av, a day designated for finding one's predestined soulmate, and one of the happiest days on the Jewish calendar.

- 2. Type youtube.com in the navigation bar and press enter.
- 3. In YouTube, type Congregation Sons of Zion (not just "Sons of Zion") in the box that says Search and them click on the magnifying glass or press enter.
- 4. Click on the video that has a red "Live" button on the bottom right corner. It may take up to 45 seconds for the video to load.



July 15, 2020: Saul inspects his produce in his front yard vegetable garden, which has kept him busy this summer.




May 25, 2020: For his birthday, Saul and Shoshana made a raised vegetable bed for their son, Noam. Now he is into growing tomatoes!
