About the Month of Adar

Known as a month of celebration and happiness, the late-winter month of Adar contains the joyous holiday of Purim that takes place mid-month. Purim, however, isn't the only thing that makes Adar special. The Hebrew name "Adar" is related to the word "adir," which denotes strength and power.

Adar is the only month in the Jewish calendar that comes back for seconds. The Jewish leap year, or shanah me'uberet (literally "pregnant year" in Hebrew), occurs approximately once every three years. In order to assure that the lunar months of the Jewish year stay in sync with the solar calendar, an additional month of Adar is added.

This year we enjoy a single Adar.

LIFELONG TEEN EDUCATOR TO RECEIVE HOLOCAUST EDUCATION AWARD



BOSTON, MASS. (Issued March 2025) – A lifelong educator who has mentored hundreds of teens and inspired them to appreciate their Jewish heritage and history is being honored by the Jewish community.

Aaron Kischel of Stoughton, Mass., will be the recipient of the fifth annual Stephan Ross Excellence in Holocaust Education Award, presented by the New England Friends of March of the Living (NEF MOTL). The prestigious award is named for Holocaust survivor Stephan Ross, founder of the New England Holocaust Memorial.

Making the announcement was Irv Kempner, President/CEO of NEF MOTL, part of the International MOTL which annually brings thousands of teens from around the world to Poland and Israel to study the history of the Holocaust and examine the roots of prejudice, intolerance and hatred.

Kempner says, "The trip instills the foundation for participants to emerge as community leaders working toward a just and compassionate world. Kischel was recipient of the Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs New England Region's 'Keeper of the Flame' Award and was recognized for his decades of service to the Conservative Movement (USCJ) as a USY leader, advisor and mentor. He was Executive Director of the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism for 45 years. He has been involved with CJP's Boston-Haifa Connection.

Kempner adds, "Aaron's tireless efforts in Holocaust education have left an indelible mark on the lives of countless individuals. As a docent, you've demonstrated unwavering dedication to empowering Jewish youth and preserving the memories of the Holocaust. You have inspired them to become upstanders for Israel, promoting social action to fight antisemitism. Your work has been a beacon of hope, ensuring that future generations 'never forget' and become leaders for tomorrow. Your commitment has inspired our Kempner Family Foundation to make a significant donation to the NEF MOTL Teen Trip Scholarship Fund in your honor."

Proceeds from the event and all tax-deductible MOTL donations directly support the Scholarship Fund. The group is committed to ensuring that every accepted teen can afford to participate. The 2025 trip is fully booked.
